Alex Colville and Lawren P. Harris at Mount Allison University, graduating in 1958.

Throughout his career, Forrestall has received many awards and honours including Member of the

Royal Canadian Academy of the Arts (1973), Order of Canada (1986), the 125th Anniversary of Canada Medal (1992) and the Order of Nova Scotia (2007).

TOM FORRESTALL's work has been exhibited nationally and internationally in numerous solo and

group exhibitions including Art Gallery of Nova Scotia; Beaverbrook Art Gallery, Fredericton,

New Brunswick; Canada House, London, U.K.; Hungarian National Museum, Budapest;
